RESOLUTION FOR SHORTLIST OF CONSULTANTS

Detailed Engineering Design of the Proposed South Luna Ramps Project

WHEREAS, the **Bases Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA)** advertised the Request for Expression of Interest for the **Detailed Engineering Design of the Proposed South Luna Ramps Project**, Fort Bonifacio, Taguig City in newspaper of general circulation and posted the same in the **BCDA** website, the PhilGEPS and conspicuous places in the BCDA premises;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement, there were ten (10) interested proponents who secured the eligibility documents and, subsequently, submitted their respective accomplished eligibility documents, namely:

- a) Philipps Technical Consultants Corp. (Philipps);
- b) Urban Integrated Consultants, Inc. (Urban);
- c) Filipinas Dravo Corporation (Fildravo);
- d) Infra Consultants in the Philippines (Infra);
- e) TCGI Engineers (TCGI);
- f) Joint Venture of UP Planades & Parsons Brinckerhoff Philippines Inc.;
- g) Schema Konsult, Inc. (Schema);
- h) KE Asia, Inc. (KE Asia);
- i) E.H. Sison Engineers, Inc. (EH Sison); and
- j) United Technologies, Inc. (UTI).

WHEREAS, the BAC-C, in the presence of the representatives from the consultancy firms, opened the accomplished eligibility documents on 28 July 2010 to establish the presence or absence of the required eligibility documents and all ten (10) interested proponents passed the eligibility screening;

WHEREAS, for the determination of shortlisting, the submitted eligibility documents were evaluated further to determine the compliance/non-compliance to minimum criteria for shortlisting. The results of the evaluation are as follows:

8. Schema	Proposed Project Manager has 1.10 years experience as project manager.	Did not meet the required minimum five (5) years of experience as project manager.
9. Philipps	Proposed Project Manager has 2 years experience as project manager.	Did not meet the required minimum five (5) years of experience as project manager.
10. JV of Planades & PB	Proposed Project Manager has 2 years experience as project manager.	Did not meet the required minimum five (5) years of experience as project manager.

WHEREAS, KE Asia, TCGI, UTI, Fildravo, Urban and EH Sison complied with the criteria for shortlisting while Infra, Schema, Philipps and the JV of Planades and PB did not meet the required minimum five (5) years experience of some personnel to be assigned to the project. Therefore, only proponents which complied with the criteria for shortlisting were evaluated for shortlisting, and the result are as follows:
