This Bid Bulletin clarifies the queries that were raised during the Pre-Bid Conference on 27 May 2022 at 10:00 AM and queries sent through e-mail by prospective bidders, as well as other matters relative to the **PROCUREMENT OF BCDA IT EQUIPMENT 2022**, as shown in the table below:

1.	Clarification if the full replacement of defective unit/s is 30 working days from the date of the delivery of the items.	, ,
		Service units, however, must be provided for temporary use by BCDA within 48 hours from receipt by supplier of notice of defective units.
2.	Verification on the full replacement of defective unit/s. Can we relax for 30 days/45 days? For us resellers, IT companies only accept full replacement if returned within 7 days, complete with accessories and undamaged box.	be made within 45 days from receipt /delivery date to BCDA.
3.	For the 2 units of Desktop: Ports: min of 4 usb ports, is this referring to USB C or any type of USB port?	The minimum requirement of 4 USB ports is referring to any type and combination of USB ports.

5.	For the PC Workstation, is it required to have an Integrated Intel SATA Controller? Can you consider it to be just an Integrated SATA Controller, so it is not specifically the brand Intel?	controllers.
6.	Is there a warranty for accessories of laptops, notebooks, and desktops?	The warranty for the accessories of laptops and desktops is one (1) year.

II. General Reminders







The Opening of Bids will be held face-to-face at the BCDA Board Room, 2/F Bonifacio Technology Center, 31st corner 2nd Avenue, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City, with a video coverage.

Bidders may choose to attend Opening of Bids in person or online via zoom.

For those who are attending in person, the following guidelines must be followed:

- A maximum of two (2) persons per participating bidder are allowed to attend the Opening of Bids and will be required to follow the BCDA Health Protocol for Visitors;
- The representative is required to present his/her vaccination card before he/she can be allowed inside the BCDA office;
- Compliance to social distancing, wearing of face masks, and body temperature screening inside BCDA office must be observed; and
- Observers/representatives who show signs of COVID-19 related symptoms such as cough, flu, fever, high body temperature, and sneezing are advised not to proceed to the BCDA Office since they will not be allowed to enter the BCDA premises.
