**Rebidding for the Supply, Delivery, and Installation of Sports Equipment
for the NAS – Phase 1 at New Clark City**

We are pleased to provide further clarifications on the following eligibility requirements for the **Rebidding for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of Sports Equipment for the NAS – Phase 1 at New Clark City**:

Queries	Clarification
1. For Item 11, Table Tennis Feeder. The requirement is 75 shoots per minute, is it possible to lower it to 70 shoots per minute and above?	No. 75 shoots per minute is the minimum performance standard. A higher capacity is acceptable.
2. What is the required warranty for the equipment?	Manufacturer's warranty.
3. Please clarify the cost of bidding documents for this project.	Pursuant to Annex 8 of the RIRR of RA 9184, since the ABC for this project is Php9,997,000.00 , the cost of its bidding documents is Ph10,000.00 .
4. For Item No. 3, Basket shot clock (with controller) - For digit height: 20cm and 12cm. Is it possible to accept our offer - 25cm and 16cm?	Yes. 20cm and 12cm is the minimum digit height, a taller height is acceptable.
5. For Item No. 5, Sports Team Benches - For high-grade aluminum material. Is it acceptable that we offer Extruded Aluminum? Is it also considered as grade aluminum?	Yes. The Extruded Aluminum is high grade and acceptable, as is Cast Aluminum.
6. For Item No. 6, Handball Goal - for aluminum square posts and crossbar 80x80mm x 2mm wall thickness. Is it possible to consider 80x80x2.5mm wall thickness? The word knocked down is also the same with PORTABLE.	Yes. 2mm wall thickness is the minimum, and a 2.5mm wall thickness of aluminum is acceptable. Yes. Portable goals are acceptable, "knocked down" may be for delivery and initial assembly on-site only.
7. For Item No. 9 - Badminton Feeder Trainer - Dimension 58x53x49cm. Our dimension offer is 58x53x52cm. Is it acceptable?	Yes. The dimensions of Badminton Feeder Trainers vary, this specification may be removed as it is not relevant to the item. As such, other dimensions are acceptable. It is the feeder capacity and rate that are important for this item.
8. In Bid Data Sheet Clause 7.1 "Subcontracting is allowed. The bidder may subcontract portions of the Project, provided that the maximum percentage allowed to be subcontracted shall not exceed twenty percent (20%) of the ABC on a per lot basis." It means we can join the bidding	Yes, but it must be emphasized pursuant to No. 3 of the Invitation to Bid, that the bidder is limited to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of

even if all the items are traded internationally?	which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA No. 5183.
9. Is the bid or awarding of items per lot or line basis?	The bidding is for the entire lot.
10. Can we bid for better/higher specifications for the equipment that has measurement? But the Certification from Sports Federations will be the same so that prospective bidders like us can join this bidding.	Please follow the TOR-MPSS/Tech Specs and ABC for the lot. Equipment has specific measurement requirements (ex. Basketball goals/backstop, etc.) as listed in the Tech Specifications unless otherwise clarified in the Bid Bulletin(s). Certification from the Sports Federation is also a requirement for some equipment in the lot. Yes, you are encouraged to join the bid.
11. Do you require a color coding of envelopes and folders for sealing and marking?	No. There is no required color coding.
12. For sports team benches - no backrest required? Just weatherproof leather upholstery and powder-coated aluminum frame?	The sports team benches are to be made of aluminum with no backrest required. Please disregard/delete "weather-proof leather upholstery type and powder coated type" - this refers to different bench types.

Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC)	<p>The Bidder must have completed a single contract that is similar to the project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC; or at least two (2) similar completed contracts with the aggregate amount equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC and the largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to at least half of the percentage (25%) of the ABC.</p> <p>A similar contract shall have been completed within ten (10) years prior to the date of submission and receipt of a bid. For this purpose, contracts similar to the Project shall be</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Contract for the Supply, Delivery, and Installation of Sports Equipment; and/or 2. Contracts for the Supply, delivery, and installation of Physical Therapy &/or Rehabilitation Equipt.
Financial Component	<p>Original of duly signed and accomplished Financial Bid Form; <u>and</u> Original of duly signed and accomplished <u>Price Schedule</u></p> <p>Note: The Bidder must submit a cost breakdown (price for each line item) and the total amount should not exceed the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the Project</p>
Product Brochure OR Manufacturer's Certificate	<p>It is required that the Bidders submit Product Brochures and/or other related documents containing the description and specifications of each item to be offered and OR Certificate from the Manufacturer, certifying compliance in all the specifications of each item to be offered as part of their technical envelope during the opening of bids.</p>

The above changes further amend the bidding documents, accordingly. The Opening of Bids will be held face-to-face at the BCDA Board Room, 2/F Bonifacio Technology Center, 31st corner 2nd Avenue, Bonifacio Global City, Taguig City, with video coverage.

Bidders may choose to attend the Opening of Bids in person or online via zoom.

For those who are attending in person, the following guidelines must be followed:

- A maximum of two (2) persons per participating bidder are allowed to attend the Opening of Bids and will be required to follow the BCDA Health Protocol for Visitors;
- The representative is required to present his/her vaccination card before he/she can be allowed inside the BCDA office;
- Compliance to social distancing, wearing of face masks, and body temperature screening inside BCDA office must be observed; and
- Observers/representatives who show signs of COVID-19 related symptoms such as cough, flu, fever, high body temperature, and sneezing are advised not to proceed to the BCDA Office since they will not be allowed to enter the BCDA premises.
