## Bidding for the Procurement of Materials for the Construction of Patrol Road Between Primary And Secondary Fence At Clark International Airport

RESOLUTION NO. BG-2017-031
WHEREAS, the BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA) has put on bid the Procurement of Materials for the Construction of Patrol road Between Primary and Secondary Fence at Clark International Airport with an Approved Budget for the Contract ( ABC ) in the amount of Pesos: FIFTY FIVE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY TWO THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SEVENTEEN AND FORTY NINE CENTAVOS (PHP 55,532,217.49), inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees, with breakdown as follows:

WHEREAS, the BAC-G, through its Secretariat, advertised the Invitation to Bid (IB) in a newspaper of nationwide circulation on 03 July 2017 and posted the same in the BCDA website, DBM Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) website and in a conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA continuously for seven (7) calendar days;
WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, eight (8) interested bidders bought the bid documents, namely: 1) Subiccon Corporation; 2) F.A. Asprer Construction; 3) R.D. Policarpio \& Co., Inc.; 4) Cohaco Merchandising \& Development Corporation; 5) Allied Quad Construction and Trading; 6) Jelay Construction \& Supply; 7) Kawaii Onna Construction; and, 8) Arky Construction and Supply;

WHEREAS, during the Opening of Bids held on 21 July 2017, five (5) out of the eight (8) participating bidders who submitted proposals, having submitted the required eligibility documents, were found to be "eligible", thus, their financial proposals were opened which were likewise found to be complying, as shown in the Abstract of Bids (hereto attached as Annex " $A$ " and made an integral part of this Resolution), with the list of the eligible bidder that submitted the Lowest/Single Calculated Bid for a specific lot summarized and shown below:

WHEREAS, on 26-27 July 2017, the Technical Working Group (TWG) conducted postqualification of the three (3) eligible bidders to determine whether they comply with and are responsive to the requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents; and based on the Post-Qualification Report of the TWG (hereto attached as Annex B), Subiccon Corp. and F.A. Asprer Construction passed the post-qualification stage while Allied Quad failed to submit any of the post-qualification documents, thus was recommended to be postdisqualified;

WHEREAS, on 01 August 2017, the TWG conducted post-qualification evaluation of Cohaco Merchandising \& Devt. Corp., the bidder with the Second Lowest Calculated Bid, and after careful examination, validation and verification of all its eligibility, legal, technical, and financial documents, as submitted to the BAC, its bid has been found Complying and Responsive, as summarized in the TWG's Post Qualification Report on Cohaco Merchandising \& Devt. Corp. (hereto attached as Annex "C");

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods, hereby RESOLVE, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to recommend the following:

1. To declare each of the three (3) eligible bidders as having the Lowest/Single Calculated and Responsive Bids (LCRB/SCRB) for the respective Lot in the Procurement of Materials for the Construction of Patrol Road Between Primary and Secondary Fence at Clark International Airport, to wit:

Hundred Fifty Nine Thousand Three Hundred Sixty One Pesos (Php3,459,361.00); with each and every contract amount inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;
3. To issue the corresponding Notice of Award to each of the three companies, namely: 1) F.A. ASPRER CONSTRUCTION; 2) SUBICCON CORPORATION; and, 3) COHACO MERCHANDISING \& DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION; (Copy Attached).
