**RESOLUTION OF AWARD
(RESO NO. BG2019-025)**

WHEREAS, the BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA) subjected to competitive public bidding the Procurement of Security Services for the following Areas of Responsibility (AOR) of *i) II (Fort Bonifacio - Open Area), ii) IV-A (BCDA Clark Facilities) and iii) IV-B (New Clark City Project)* with Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Forty-Three Million Eight Thousand One Hundred Eleven Pesos (PhP43, 008,111.00) for the first year**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees, broken down into the following lots:

WHEREAS, the BAC for Goods, through its Secretariat, posted the Invitation to Bid on 01 November 2019 in the following:

- a. DBM Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS);
- b. BCDA Website; and
- c. Conspicuous place reserved for the purpose in the premises of BCDA

WHEREAS, in response to said posting, three (3) companies submitted their bids for the following specific Areas of Responsibility (AOR):

WHEREAS, during the Opening of Bids on 04 December 2019, the BAC for Goods received and opened proposals of the above-mentioned bidders. Based on the eligibility documents submitted by the bidders, the BAC for Goods declared the bidders eligible, thus, their financial proposals were evaluated and are shown below:

WHEREAS, after the preliminary evaluation of the submitted bids, BAC-G found that Catalina Security Agency submitted the eligibility requirements and technical proposal, and offered the lowest financial proposals for the AOR II and AOR IV-A, as shown below. Catalina Security Agency was declared the Lowest Calculated Bid for AOR II and AOR IV-A;

WHEREAS, Northcom Security and Investigation Agency submitted the eligibility requirements and technical proposal, and offered the lowest financial proposal for AOR- IV in the amount of Php15,213,799.39, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees. Northcom Security and Investigation Agency was declared the Lowest Calculated Bid for AOR IV-B. *The Abstract of Bids is hereby attached as "Annex "A".*

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing and consistent with Section 34 of Rule X – Post-Qualification of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, the Technical Working Group (TWG) of the BAC for Goods conducted Post-Qualification on 16-17 December 2019 to determine whether *i)* Catalina and *ii)* Northcom are compliant with, and are responsive to the requirements and conditions specified in the Bidding Documents.

WHEREAS, upon post-qualification conducted by the TWG and after careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, technical and financial documents submitted by *i)* Catalina and *ii)* Northcom, their bids have been found Compliant and Responsive. *The Post-Qualification Report is hereby attached as Annex "B".*

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to recommend the following:

1. To declare **Catalina Security Agency** as the bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for the Procurement of Security Services for the following AOR, *i*) II (Fort Bonifacio -Open Area) and *ii*) IV-A (BCDA Clark Facilities), and to award the contract to Catalina Security Agency, Inc. in the amount of **Nineteen Million Three Hundred Eighty Four Thousand Two Hundred Seventy Five Pesos and 12/100 (Php19,384,275.12)** for AOR II (Fort Bonifacio-Open Area) and in the amount of **Seven Million Two Hundred Sixty-Three Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Eight Pesos and 52/100 (Php7,263,188.52)** for AOR IV-A (BCDA Clark Facilities), respectively, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;
2. To declare **Northcom Security and Investigation Agency, Inc.** as the bidder with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for the Procurement of Security Services for AOR IV-B (New Clark City Project) and to award the contract to Northcom Security and Investigation Agency, Inc. in the amount of **Fifteen Million Two Hundred Thirteen Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Nine Pesos and 39/100 (Php15,213,799.39)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;
3. To issue the respective Notices of Award to Catalina and Northcom; and
4. To direct the Security Services Unit, being the end-user unit, to furnish the BAC for Goods copies of the duly conformed Notices of Award, Notices to Proceed and the duly executed agreements/contracts.
