Procurement of Consulting Services for the Preparation of the Comprehensive Master Development Plan for Camp John Hay, Baguio City

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-010
(Declaration of the Single Rated Bid (SRB))

WHEREAS, the Bases Conversion and Development Authority (BCDA) is mandated under Republic Act No. 7227, as amended by Republic Act No. 7917, to accelerate the sound and balanced conversion into alternative productive uses of the Clark and Subic military reservations and their extensions, to raise funds by the sale of portions of Metro Manila Military Camps and to apply said funds for the development and conversion into alternative productive uses of these properties;

WHEREAS, on **01 February 2025**, the BCDA, through its Bids and Awards Committee for Consulting Services (BAC-C), posted a Request for Expression of Interest (REI) including the bidding documents on PhilGEPS, the BCDA Website, and in a conspicuous place within the premises of BCDA for the **Procurement of Consulting Services for the Preparation of the Comprehensive Master Development Plan for Camp John Hay, Baguio City** under **Section 10 - Competitive Bidding of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184**, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of **Pesos: Forty-Five Million and 00/100 (PhP 45,000,000.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees;

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisement of the REI and bidding documents, five (5) prospective bidders submitted their Eligibility Documents for the **Procurement of Consulting Services for the Preparation of the Comprehensive Master Development Plan for Camp John Hay, Baguio City** prior to the set deadline for submission on 07 March 2025, at 9:00 a.m., to wit:

- 1) RO Architectonics Design Studio;
- 2) Palafox Associates;
- 3) Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.;
- 4) SyCip Gorres Velayo & Co., Ove Arup and Partners Hong Kong Limited - Philippines Branch, KMC Savills, Inc. (Joint Venture); and
- 5) Planning and Development Research Foundation, Inc. (PLANADES)

WHEREAS, Section 30.1 of the Revised IRR of R.A. No. 9184 provides:

"xxx... the BAC shall check the submitted documents of each bidder against a checklist of required documents to ascertain if they are all present, using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion, as stated in the Instructions to Bidders. If a bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated "passed" for that particular requirement. In this regard, bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered as "failed." xxx"

WHEREAS, on 07 March 2025, the Eligibility Documents of the five (5) prospective bidders were opened and subjected to a preliminary evaluation by determining the presence or absence of the required documents using the non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion;

WHEREAS, the submissions of Palafox Associates, Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp., SyCip Gorres Velayo & Co., Ove Arup and Partners Hong Kong Limited - Philippines Branch, KMC Savills, Inc. (Joint Venture), and Planning and Development Research Foundation, Inc. (PLANADES) were subjected to detailed evaluation, while RO Architectonics Design Studio was declared “ineligible” to further participate in the bidding on the following grounds:

If a prospective bidder is rated “failed” in any of the eligibility requirements, he shall be considered ineligible to participate in the bidding.”</p>

WHEREAS, Section II (Eligibility Documents), Item No. 8.4 of the Bidding Documents provides that, an “incomplete or patently insufficient” submission shall be considered “failed” for the particular eligibility requirement concerned and is therefore “ineligible” to participate in the bidding. Pertinent provisions thereof are as follows:

8.4. The eligibility of each prospective bidder shall be determined by examining each bidder's eligibility requirements or statements against a checklist of requirements, using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion, as stated in the Request for Expression of Interest, and shall be determined as either “eligible” or “ineligible.” If a prospective bidder submits the specific eligibility document required, he shall be rated “passed” for that particular requirement. In this regard, failure to submit a requirement, or an incomplete or patently insufficient submission, shall be considered “failed” for the particular eligibility requirement concerned. If a prospective bidder is rated “passed” for all the eligibility requirements, he shall be considered eligible to participate in the bidding, and the BAC shall mark the set of eligibility documents of the prospective bidder concerned as “eligible.” If a prospective bidder is rated “failed” in any of the eligibility requirements, he shall be considered ineligible to participate in the bidding, and the BAC shall mark the set of eligibility documents of the prospective bidder concerned as “ineligible.” In either case, the BAC chairperson or his duly designated authority shall countersign the markings.

WHEREAS, this provision is based on Section 30.1 of the Revised IRR of R. A. No. 9184, which states that:

“30.1 The BAC shall open the first bid envelopes in public to determine each bidder’s compliance with the documents required to be submitted for eligibility and for the technical requirements, as prescribed in this IRR.

For this purpose, the BAC shall check the submitted documents of each bidder against a checklist of required documents to ascertain if they are all present, using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion, as stated in the Instructions to Bidders.

If a bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated “passed” for that particular requirement. In this regard, bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered as “failed.” Otherwise, the BAC shall rate the said first bid envelope as “passed.”

WHEREAS, the BAC-C issued a Notice of Ineligibility to **RO Architectonics Design Studio** on 07 March 2025 and was given three (3) calendar days from the date of Notice to file a request for reconsideration or until 10 March 2025, in accordance with Section 55.1 of the Revised IRR of R. A. No. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 10 March 2025, BCDA received a letter from **RO Architectonics Design Studio** requesting reconsideration for the adverse findings of the BAC-C, which earlier declared their firm as “ineligible” for non-compliance with the requirements specified in the bidding documents;

WHEREAS, on 17 March 2025, the BAC-C responded to **RO Architectonics Design Studio**, denying their request for reconsideration;

WHEREAS, the submitted Eligibility Documents of the four (4) prospective bidders were subjected to detailed evaluation and shortlisting on 08 March 2025 to 19 March 2025 in accordance with Section 24 of the Revised IRR of R.A. No. 9184, and using the criteria and rating system for shortlisting as provided under Clause 9.2 of Eligibility Data Sheet (EDS) for the consulting services;

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group (TWG) presented the results of the evaluation of the Eligibility Documents and shortlisting, and the BAC-C deliberated on the results on 20 March 2025;

WHEREAS, the results of the Evaluation/Eligibility Check and Shortlisting likewise showed that two (2) out of four (4) prospective bidders were rated “PASSED” and garnered a total score above the required minimum score of 70%, to wit:

WHEREAS, the results of the Evaluation/Eligibility Check and Shortlisting show that two (2) out of four (4) prospective bidders were rated **"FAILED"** due to the absence of the required documents and/or non-compliance with the requirements provided under the Eligibility Documents and Terms of Reference (TOR) for the Consulting Services, and 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. No. 9184, to wit:

WHEREAS, on 20 March 2025, the BAC-C Resolution No. 2025-006 was approved, declaring **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.** and **SyCip Gorres Velayo & Co., Ove Arup and Partners Hong Kong Limited - Philippines Branch, KMC Savills, Inc. (Joint Venture)** as **ELIGIBLE** and **SHORTLISTED** bidders for the **Procurement of Consulting Services for the Preparation of the Comprehensive Master Development Plan for Camp John Hay, Baguio City** under **Section 10 - Competitive Bidding of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184**, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of **Pesos: Forty-Five Million and 00/100 (PhP 45,000,000.00)**, inclusive of all applicable taxes and fees, which can proceed to the next stage of the bidding for the Consulting Services pursuant to Section 24.5.4 of 2016 RIRR of R.A. No. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 20 March 2025, the Notice of Eligibility was sent to **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.** and **SyCip Gorres Velayo & Co., Ove Arup and Partners Hong Kong Limited - Philippines Branch, KMC Savills, Inc. (Joint Venture)**, inviting them to participate in the bidding for the Consulting Services. On the other hand, the Notice of Ineligibility was sent to **Palafox Associates** and **Planning and Development Research Foundation, Inc.**

(PLANADES), and there was no request for reconsideration received from them within the prescribed period pursuant to Section 55.1 of 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. No. 9184;

WHEREAS, on 27 March 2025, at 10:00 AM, a Pre-bid Conference was held for the aforementioned Consulting Service which was attended by **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.** and **SyCip Gorres Velayo & Co., Ove Arup and Partners Hong Kong Limited - Philippines Branch, KMC Savills, Inc. (Joint Venture)**;

WHEREAS, **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.** submitted their Technical and Financial Proposals prior to the deadline set for the submission of Bids for the Consulting Services on 23 April 2025, 9:00 AM. On the same day at 10:00 AM, the Technical Proposal of **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.** was opened and subjected to a preliminary examination by determining the presence or absence of the required documents using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion;

WHEREAS, from 23 April 2025 to 25 April 2025, the BAC-C TWG conducted a detailed evaluation of the Technical Proposals of **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.** in accordance with Section 33 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R. A. No. 9184, as well as the criteria and rating system for the technical proposal as provided under Clause 25.3 of the Bid Data Sheet (BDS) for the Consulting Services;

WHEREAS, on 25 April 2025, the BAC-C deliberated on the Report of TWG on the results of the said detailed evaluation. The results show that **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.** was rated "**PASSED**" having complied with the required documents provided under the Bid Documents and Terms of Reference for the consulting services, and 2016 Revised IRR of R. A. No. 9184. Below is the evaluation result of the technical proposals of **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.**:

NOW, THEREFORE, foregoing considered and after careful evaluation and thorough deliberation of the detailed evaluation of the submitted Technical Proposals of **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.** for the **Procurement of Consulting Services for the Preparation of the Comprehensive Master Development Plan for Camp John Hay, Baguio City**, We, the Members of the BAC-C, hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby RESOLVED to recommend the following:

- 1) To declare the bid of **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.** as **"PASSED"**;
- 2) To recommend to the Head of the Procuring Entity that, **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.**, having complied with the requirements provided under the Bidding Documents and Terms of Reference for the Consulting Services, and 2016 Revised IRR of R. A. No. 9184 be declared as the **Single Rated Bid (SRB)** for the procurement of **Consulting Services for the Preparation of the Comprehensive Master Development Plan for Camp John Hay, Baguio City**; and
- 3) To proceed with the opening of the financial proposal of **Projects Design Plus Architecture Management Corp.** in accordance with Sections 33.2.1.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R. A. No. 9184.
