

CERTIFICATION Undertaking of Early Procurement Activities (EPA)

I hereby certify that the BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (BCDA) has not undertaken Early Procurement Activities (EPA) for at least fifty (50%) of the value of eligible procurement projects in its Indicative Annual Procurement Plan provided in the National Expenditure Plan (NEP) for the Fiscal Year 2021, as shown below:

There was no EPA undertaken due to the necessity for BCDA to await budget advice/clearance from the Department of Budget Management (DBM) before commencing with the procurement process of Projects funded by the General Appropriation Act.

Likewise, the BCDA GAA-funded projects are under an Infrastructure Development Program where the final specifications, scope of works or detailed engineering design, or Terms of Reference (TOR) are examined by other related government agencies affected by these projects. The review alone takes some time and affects the commencement of the procurement process.
